1 Introduction

This Documentation describes how you can install a patch from the Railo Preview environment into an existing Railo installation.

Please note that the patches available from the preview environment always contain pre releases.

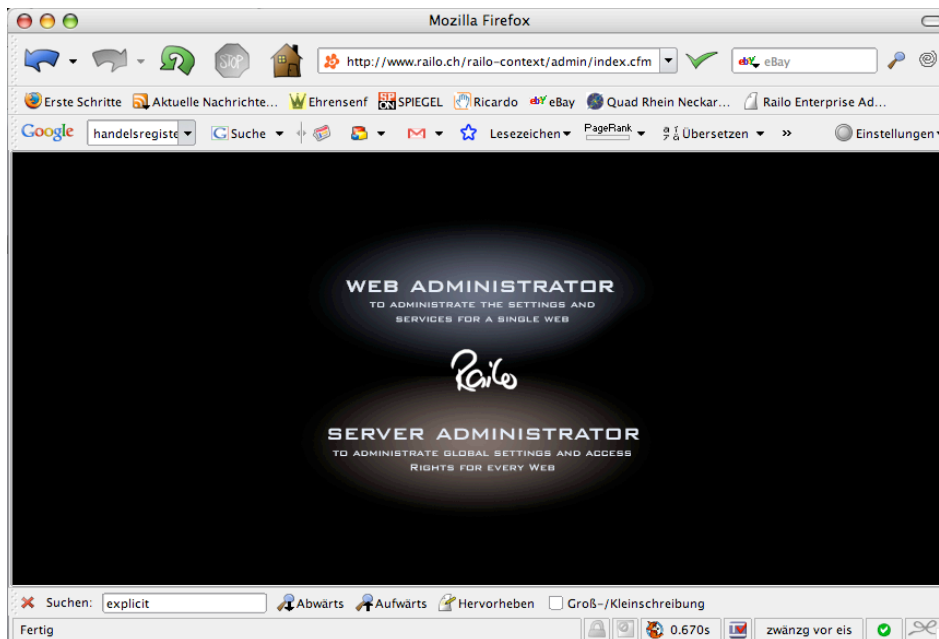
1.1 General

For the sake simplicity and readability we will always use the male form of nouns. By doing so we imply the female form as well.

We deliberately abandon the usage of variations of expressions in order to avoid repetitions and increase clarity.

2 Approach

Navigate to the Railo Administrator by entering the URL „/railo-context/admin.cfm“ into any browser.

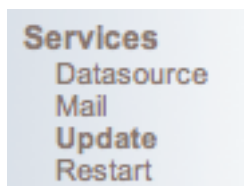


Click on the Server administrator and log in.





Please select the option „Service/update“.



Change the URL in the right part of the window to <http://preview.railo.ch> (please change this URL at the end of the update back to <http://www.railo.ch>) and confirm the change by hitting the 'update' button.



If a preview patch is available, Railo will display an edit field containing the changes and fixes made in this patch. You may now use the execute update button in order to patch your current version.



After the update has been executed and imported the login appears (it might be possible, that the page displays blank. In this case just hit the refresh button of your browser. Since Railo needs to be restarted your current session will be killed and the login mask appears.
